Surveillance Data Committee (SDC)

- The SDC continues its work facilitating the development of manuscripts and other data products. A few currently in development:
 - Access to Specialty Care Clinics Among Cases with Down Syndrome
 - Periconceptional Extreme Ambient Heat Exposure and Selected Birth Defects
 - o Comparison of State-Specific Defect Lists use for Reporting and Coding
- The SDC has also been planning for the next data call (2025) and subsequent spotlight papers (2025, 2026). Part of this entails working with the SGSC on the rollout of the new Program Performance Summary Tool which will be incorporated into the next data call and future publications.
 - o Data Call will be sent after the conference
